



**Supplementary Regulations
for
The 2018 Queensland Motorkhana Championship
and
The 2018 Queensland Motorkhana Series Round 2**

Sunday 17/06/2018

1. The Event

The Event shall be known as The 2018 Queensland Motorkhana Championship and Round 2 of the 2018 Queensland Motorkhana Series and be a **State Championship and Open Event**.

2. Authority

The Event is authorised by CAMS Permit Number – **418/1706/05** and shall be held under the provisions of FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices and the National Competition Rules (NCR) of CAMS, the current CAMS Motorkhana Regulations, The CAMS Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) Policy, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations, addenda and instructions as may be issued, subject to NCR 69 of the current CAMS Manual.

This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the Event.

5. Entries

Entries for the QMC and QMS open upon publication of these Regulations and discount entries close 5.00pm 14th June and close at the venue 9.00am 17/06/18 QMC / QMS Entry is \$55.00, with a discount of \$5.00 for entries received before the discount entries closing date 14/6/2018 and \$30.00 for Juniors with no discount. All money can be paid on the day of the Event.

The maximum number of entries will be 70.

Entries may be refused in accordance with NCR 83.

Entries in the Qld. Championship shall also be entered in the Qld. Series.

All entries must be on the official Entry Form which can be found on the HSCCQ web site at www.hscq.com/index.php/event/ and this also indicates how to pay the appropriate Entry Fee. All cheques, etc. are to be made payable to Holden Sporting Car Club of Qld.

CTP Insurance

All Competitors of Queensland registered vehicles must present to the secretary of the Event a current CTP Insurance extension for the entered vehicle for that day, all unregistered vehicles will be covered by CAMS.

6. Licences

All Competitors must be a member of a CAMS affiliated club and be in possession of a CAMS L2NS, L2NSJ or superior Licence. Such licence must be presented to the Secretary of the Event. All partnerships and registered companies must hold a CAMS Competitors Licence.

7. Draw

Starting order for all Competitors will be determined by ballot to be held at the event on 17th June 2018.

Competitors may be rotated in running order to avoid one person starting each test.

8. Abandonment

The Organisers reserve the right to cancel the Event if the total number of QMC/QMS competitors is less than twenty-five (25).

The Event may be altered, postponed, abandoned or cancelled at the sole discretion of the organisers, subject to the provisions of NCR 59.

9. Venue

The Event shall be conducted at Willowbank Raceway on Sunday 17/06/18. The type of surface shall be Sealed.

10. Alcohol, drug and other Substances

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

11. Timetable

Book-in Hours: 8.30am to 9.30am.

Scrutineering:..... 8.30am and close at 10.00am

Briefing of competitors:..... 10.15am.

Event start:..... 10.30am

Extension of Scrutineering times will be at the discretion of the Clerk of Course or Chief Scrutineer.

16. Scrutiny

All vehicles must comply with Schedule A and Group 4H of the current CAMS Manual. Approved helmets and apparel, in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual. Cars must be adequately muffled 95db(A) is the maximum noise level. Choice of tyres will be free except with reference to the CAMS Motorkhana Code Group I.2 to I.5. Attention will be paid to the cleanliness and tidiness of vehicles.

All Competitors must present the following Documents at Scrutiny a current competition licence, current CAMS affiliation card and a vehicle Log Book as applicable and **CTP Extension as applicable**.

16. Tests

There will be a minimum of Six tests taken from the list below:

1: Spiro Slalom 2: Dollar 3: Plumb Crazy 4: Pine Tree

5: Double Kidney 6: Double Hat 7: Arrowhead 8: Offcentric

9: Spearhead 10: Top Hat 11: Big Eyes 12: Eccentric

13: Rev Spiro Slalom 14: Noughts & Crosses 16: Serpentine

16. Classes

There will be seven classes as follows:

Class A= Production vehicles with a wheelbase up to 2160mm

Class B= Production vehicles with a wheelbase from 2161 to 2390mm

Class C= Production vehicles with a wheelbase from 2391 to 2574mm

Class D= Production vehicles with a wheelbase 2575mm and over

Class E - Production vehicles with 4 wheel drive

Class F - Front wheel drive specials

Class G - Rear wheel drive specials

Production vehicles fitted with a hand braking system other than: • Standard • Altered ratchet • Changed mechanical advantage • Hydraulic

Or any vehicle which in the opinion of CAMS represents an attempt to circumvent or defeat the spirit of the concept of a production vehicle shall be classified as a special.

16. Timing

Electronic timing may be used. Timing shall start at the Competitors own time, when the leading point of the vehicle crosses the designated start line and cease when the leading point of the vehicle crosses the designated finish line.

Times for Competitors in the Queensland Motorkhana Series will be adjusted using the following formula when handicap scores are calculated.

Penalties as recorded multiplied by 1.00

Class A as recorded multiplied by 0.86

Class B as recorded multiplied by 0.86

Class C as recorded multiplied by 0.82

Class D as recorded multiplied by 0.80

Class E as recorded multiplied by 0.81

Class F as recorded multiplied by 1.00

Class G as recorded multiplied by 1.00

16. Penalties

Penalties shall be in accordance with the CAMS National Motorkhana Code, and the Queensland Addendum.

18. Pointsoring

Qld Championship Competitors shall be ranked by outright time overall and in Class.

All Competitors in the Queensland Motorkhana Series shall be ranked according to their total handicap scores after all tests have been completed by all Competitors. Competitors shall be awarded points according to their ranking which shall count towards their overall total for the Queensland Motorkhana Series. The points shall be awarded in accordance with the method decided on by the Queensland Motorkhana Advisory Panel.

18. Protests/ Appeals

Protests or appeals must be made in accordance with Part XII or Part XIII of the National Competition Rules.

19. Judges of Fact

All Officials and Timekeepers at test areas shall be deemed as Judges of Fact in accordance with NCR 181

20. Awards

Trophies may be awarded to Queensland Motorkhana Championship Competitors as per list below:

1st, 2nd, 3rd Outright and 1st and 2nd in each class

21. General

A speed limit of 10kph (walking pace) is required in all areas except the competition areas.

No Passenger will be allowed to be carried in competing vehicles unless that Passenger is an Adult acting as a trainer and safety person for a Junior by the Clerk of the Course. Refer to article 22 of these Supplementary Regulations.

22. Passengers

This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the CAMS MSPRA Policy.

- (a) A briefing must be attended by each Driver and Passenger (and guardians of each Passenger if Passenger is under 18 years of age) conducted by the Clerk of the Course prior to the MSPRA commencing.
- (b) Passengers MUST:
 - i. wear the same protective gear as a Driver
 - ii. Be fitted and restrained as required for each Automobile with consideration for their physical attributes
 - iii. Complete a Passenger Ride Entry Form and disclaimer
 - iv. Drivers must fill out a Passenger Ride Entry Form to ride as a passenger.
 - v. Be at least 12 years of age
- (c) Vehicles and Apparel used must pass Scrutiny.
- (d) Vehicles shall only carry one Passenger at a time, unless otherwise approved by CAMS."
