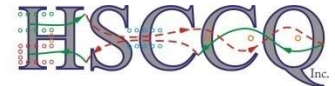


Supplementary Regulations Holden Sporting Car Club of Qld inc. 2020 Qld Motorkhana Championship & 2020 Qld Motorkhana Series Sunday 15/11/2020



The Event

The event shall be a Multi-Club Motorkhana and be known as the QLD Motorkhana Championship & Series.

Authority

The event will be conducted under the International Sporting Code of the FIA., the National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia., on Permit No: **420/1511/02**, the Speed Event Standing Regulations, the National/State Championship or Series Regulations relevant to the event, the Motorsport Australia Passenger in Vehicle Guidelines, the Motorsport Australia Come and Try Policy, these Supplementary Regulations and any further Supplementary Regulations or Bulletins which may be issued. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Safety 1st and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at www.Motorsport.org.au. Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia in relation to the event. Entries

- (a) Entries must be submitted online at www.hscq.com
- (b) Complete the online self-scrutineering assessment form which will be emailed to you once entry has been received, this must be emailed back to the organisers prior to the event – all competitors will need to fill in their acceptance form before completing their entry form
- (c) Read the Drivers Briefing notes prior filling in their acceptance form and entry form.
- (d) It is advisable to have the COVID-19 application loaded on your phone.

CTP Insurance

All competitors of Queensland registered vehicles must present to the secretary of the event a current CTP Insurance extension for the entered vehicle for that day.

Licences

All competitors must be a member of a **Motorsport Australia** affiliated club and be in possession of a relevant and current **Motorsport Australia** 2NS/J licence or higher. Such licence must be presented to the secretary of the event. All partnerships and registered companies must hold a **Motorsport Australia** Competitors Licence.

Abandonment

The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event if the total number of competitors is less than twenty (20).

The event may be altered, postponed, abandoned or cancelled at the sole discretion of the organisers, subject to the provisions of NCR 59.

Venue

The event shall be conducted at, Willowbank Raceway 15th November 2020 The type of surface shall be sealed.

Timetable

Scrutiny will start at the venue at 8.30 am., 15/11/2020 if required.

The event shall start at 10.30 am.

Alcohol, drug and other Substances

Any holder of a **Motorsport Australia** 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the **Motorsport Australia** Anti-Doping Policy and/or the **Motorsport Australia** Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the **Motorsport Australia** website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a **Motorsport Australia** 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a **Motorsport Australia** Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the **Motorsport Australia** Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

Scrutiny

There will be no scrutiny conducted at this event, Self Scrutiny Assessment forms are to be completed ref. Entries, Apparel checks may be conducted at your pit area prior to the event.

Approved crash helmets and suitable eye protection (not sunglasses) is required for all open vehicles.

Classes

There will be seven classes as follows:

Class A= wheelbase up to 2150mm

Class B= wheelbase from 2151 to 2390mm

Class C= wheelbase from 2391 to 2574mm

Class D= wheelbase 2575mm and over

Class E = Production vehicles with 4 wheel drive

Class F = Front wheel drive specials

Class G = Rear wheel drive specials

Production vehicles fitted with a hand braking system other than:

• Standard • Changed mechanical advantage • Hydraulic • Altered ratchet

Or any vehicle which in the opinion of **Motorsport Australia** represents an attempt to circumvent or defeat the spirit of the concept of a production vehicle shall be classified as a special. Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current **Motorsport Australia** Manual. Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions.

Timing

Electronic & Manual timing shall be used. Timing shall start at the competitors own time, when the vehicle breaks the designated timing line and cease when the foremost part of the vehicle crosses the finish line. Times will be adjusted using the following formula when handicap scores are calculate.

Penalties as recorded multiplied by 1.00

Class A as recorded multiplied by 0.86

Class B as recorded multiplied by 0.86

Class C as recorded multiplied by 0.82

Class D as recorded multiplied by 0.81

Penalties

Class E as recorded multiplied by 0.81

Class F as recorded multiplied by 1.00

Class G as recorded multiplied by 1.00

Penalties shall be awarded in accordance with the **Motorsport Australia** Motorkhana Regulations and the Queensland Appendix.

Pointscoreing (Results)

Qld Championship Competitors shall be ranked by outright time overall and in Class.

All competitors in the Queensland Motorkhana Series shall be ranked according to their total handicap scores after all tests have been completed by all competitors. Competitors shall be awarded points according to their ranking which shall count towards their overall total for the Queensland Motorkhana Series. The points shall be awarded in accordance with the method decided on by the Queensland Motorkhana Advisory Panel.

Protests/ Appeals

Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current **Motorsport Australia** Manual

Judges of Fact

All officials and timekeepers at test areas shall be deemed as Judges of Fact in accordance with NCR 181 and 18.2 / 18.3 of the National Motorkhana Code.

General

2 Runs will be run of each test with the fastest run counting.

Trophies may be awarded to Queensland Motorkhana Championship Competitors as per list below, but will be posted out after due to COVID-19 restrictions.

1st, 2nd, 3rd Outright and 1st and 2nd in each class

No passengers will be allowed to be carried in competing vehicles unless that passenger is an adult acting as a trainer and safety person for a junior and approved by the Clerk of Course.
