The Event

The event shall be a Multi-Club Motorkhana and be known as the HSCCQ Interclub Motorkhana with a Come & Try component

Authority

The event will be conducted under the International Sporting Code of the FIA., the National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia., on Permit No: **420/0803/01**, the Speed Event Standing Regulations, the Motorsport Australia Passenger in Vehicle Guidelines, the Motorsport Australia Come and Try Policy, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations or Bulletins which may be issued. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Safety 1st and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at www.motorsport.org.au. Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia in relation to the event. Entries

Entries open upon publication of these regulations and close at the venue 9.30 am 08/03/2020

The entry fee shall be \$60 Adults and \$30 for Juniors and must be accompanied by an official entry form.

The maximum number of entries will be 70 in order of receipt.

Entries may be refused in accordance with NCR 83 of the current Motorsport Australia manual.

Come & Try Day licence will be \$25.00, available at the Event.

CTP Insurance

All competitors of Queensland registered vehicles must present to the secretary of the event a current CTP Insurance extension for the entered vehicle for that day.

Licences

All competitors must be a member of a **Motorsport Australia** affiliated club and be in possession of a relevant and current **Motorsport Australia** 2NS/J licence or higher. Such licence must be presented to the secretary of the event. All partnerships and registered companies must hold a **Motorsport Australia** Competitors Licence.

Day Membership of HSCCQ and **Motorsport Australia** Level 1 Come & Try licences will be available for the event

Abandonment

The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event if the total number of competitors is less than twenty (20).

The event may be altered, postponed, abandoned or cancelled at the sole discretion of the organisers, subject to the provisions of NCR 59.

Venue

The event shall be conducted at, Sleeman Sports Complex 8th April 2020. The type of surface shall be sealed.

Timetable

Scrutiny will start at the venue at 8.30 am., 08/03/2020. A briefing of competitors will be held at 10.15 am.

The event shall start at 10.30 am.

Alcohol, drug and other Substances

Any holder of a Motorsport Australia 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the Motorsport Australia website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a Motorsport Australia 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

Scrutiny

Vehicles shall comply with General Requirements for Cars & Driver **Motorsport Australia** s Schedule A and Group 4H of the current **Motorsport Australia** Manual. Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current **Motorsport Australia** Manual. Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions. All vehicles with a **Motorsport Australia** Log Book must present it at Book-In and or Scrutiny.

Approved crash helmets are required for all vehicles. All competitors must present the following documents at book-in, **Motorsport Australia** Licence, Club Membership & **CTP Extension as applicable**.

(All Queensland registered cars need a CTP Extension, check your car registration papers and ask that insurer for a Rally Extension for the day of the event, giving them the name of the event and location.)

Classes

There will be seven classes as follows:

Class A= wheelbase up to 2150mm

Class B= wheelbase from 2151 to 2390mm

Class C= wheelbase from 2391 to 2574mm

Class D= wheelbase 2575mm and over

Class E = Production vehicles with 4 wheel drive

Class F = Front wheel drive specials

Class G = Rear wheel drive specials

Production vehicles fitted with a hand braking system other than:

• Standard • Changed mechanical advantage • Hydraulic • Altered ratchet

Or any vehicle which in the opinion of **Motorsport Australia** represents an attempt to circumvent or defeat the spirit of the concept of a production vehicle shall be classified as a special. Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current **Motorsport Australia** Manual. Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions.

Timing

Electronic & Manual timing shall be used. Timing shall start at the competitors own time, when the vehicle breaks the designated timing line and cease when the foremost part of the vehicle crosses the finish line. Times will be adjusted using the following formula when handicap scores are calculate.

Penalties as recorded multiplied by 1.00

Class A as recorded multiplied by 0.86

Class B as recorded multiplied by 0.86

Class C as recorded multiplied by 0.82

Class D as recorded multiplied by 0.81

Penalties

Class E as recorded multiplied by 0.81

Class F as recorded multiplied by 1.00

Class G as recorded multiplied by 1.00

Penalties shall be awarded in accordance with the **Motorsport Australia** Motorkhana Regulations and the Queensland Appendix.

Point scoring (Results)

All competitors shall be ranked according to their total timed scores after all tests have been completed by all competitors. Competitors shall be awarded points according to their ranking which shall count towards their overall total for the Holden Sporting Car Club Motorkhana Series. The points shall be awarded in accordance with the method decided on by the Queensland Motorkhana Advisory Panel.

Level 1 (Come & Try) licence holders will not be classified in the above points scoring.

Protests/ Appeals

Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current **Motorsport Australia** Manual

Judges of Fact

All officials and timekeepers at test areas shall be deemed as Judges of Fact in accordance with NCR 181 and 18.2 / 18.3 of the National Motorkhana Code.

General

2 Runs will be run of each test with the fastest run counting.

Trophies will not be awarded.

New competitors please ask any HSCCQ member for information or assistance.

Day Membership of HSCCQ and CAMS Level 1 licences will be available for the event from the event secretary.

The event will not be catered but drinks may be available.

Passengers

This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the Motorsport Australia MSPRA Policy.
