

Supplementary Regulations



Holden Sporting Car Club of Qld Inc. Interclub Motorkhana Sunday 14/04/2019



The Event

The event shall be a **Multi Club Motorkhana** incorporating a Come & Try component and will be referred to as the Interclub Motorkhana.

Authority

The event is authorised by CAMS permit No. **419/1404/02** and shall be conducted under the provisions of the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices and the National Competition Rules (NCR) of CAMS, the current CAMS Motorkhana Regulations, the CAMS Motor Sport Manual MSPRA Policy Activity, these Supplementary Regulations and any further regulations, addenda and instructions as may be issued, subject to NCR 69 of the current CAMS Manual. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S, CAMS Safety 1st and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au.

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au.

Entries

Entries open upon publication of these Regulations and close at the venue 9.30 am 14/04/2019

The entry fee shall be \$50 Adults and \$30 for Juniors and must be accompanied by an official entry form.

The maximum number of entries will be 70 in order of receipt.

Entries may be refused in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS manual.

Come & Try CAMS Day licence will be \$25.00, available at the Event.

CTP Insurance

All competitors of Queensland registered vehicles must present to the secretary of the event a current CTP Insurance extension for the entered vehicle for that day.

Licences

All competitors must be a member of a CAMS affiliated club and be in possession of a relevant and current CAMS licence. Such licence must be presented to the secretary of the event. All partnerships and registered companies must hold a CAMS Competitors Licence.

CAMS Level One (Day) licences and Day Membership of HSCCO will be available for Come & Try people.

Abandonment

The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event if the total number of competitors is less than twenty (20).

The event may be altered, postponed, abandoned or cancelled at the sole discretion of the organisers, subject to the provisions of NCR 59.

Venue

The event shall be conducted at, Willowbank Raceway 14th April 2019. The type of surface shall be sealed.

Timetable

Scrutiny will start at the venue at 8.30 am., 14/04/19. A briefing of competitors will be held at 10.15 am.

The event shall start at 10.30 am.

Alcohol, drug and other Substances

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

Scrutiny

Vehicles shall comply with General Requirements for vehicles & Drivers Schedule A and Group 4H of the current CAMS Manual. Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual. Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with a vehicle noise limit of 95dB (A) to 30 metres drive-by will apply. Apparel shall be in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motorsport. Logbooks (if issued) must be presented at Scrutiny. Approved crash helmets and suitable eye protection (not sunglasses) is required for all open vehicles. All competitors must present the following documents at book-in, CAMS Licence, Club Membership & **CTP Extension as applicable.**

Classes

There will be seven classes as follows:

Class A= wheelbase up to 2150mm

Class B= wheelbase from 2151 to 2390mm

Class C= wheelbase from 2391 to 2574mm

Class D= wheelbase 2575mm and over

Class E = Production vehicles with 4 wheel drive

Class F = Front wheel drive specials

Class G = Rear wheel drive specials

Production vehicles fitted with a hand braking system other than:

• Standard • Changed mechanical advantage • Hydraulic • Altered ratchet

Or any vehicle which in the opinion of CAMS represents an attempt to circumvent or defeat the spirit of the concept of a production vehicle shall be classified as a special. Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual. Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions.

Timing

Electronic & Manual timing shall be used. Timing shall start at the competitors own time, when the vehicle breaks the designated timing line and cease when the foremost part of the vehicle crosses the finish line. Times will be adjusted using the following formula when handicap scores are calculated for the QMS.

Penalties as recorded multiplied by 1.00

Class A as recorded multiplied by 0.86

Class B as recorded multiplied by 0.86

Class C as recorded multiplied by 0.82

Class D as recorded multiplied by 0.81

Class E as recorded multiplied by 0.81

Class F as recorded multiplied by 1.00

Class G as recorded multiplied by 1.00

Penalties

Penalties shall be awarded in accordance with the CAMS Motorkhana Code and the Queensland Appendix.

Pointsoring (Results)

All competitors shall be ranked according to their total timed scores after all tests have been completed by all competitors. Competitors shall be awarded points according to their ranking which shall count towards their overall total for the Holden Sporting Car Club Motorkhana Series. The points shall be awarded in accordance with the method decided on by the Queensland Motorkhana Advisory Panel.

Level 1 (Come & Try) licence holders will not be classified in the above points scoring.

Protests/ Appeals

Protests or appeals must be made in accordance with Part XII (Protests) and Part XIII (Appeals) of the current NCR's.

Judges of Fact

All officials and timekeepers at test areas shall be deemed as Judges of Fact in accordance with NCR 181 and 18.2 / 18.3 of the National Motorkhana Code.

General

2 Runs will be run of each test with the fastest run counting.

Trophies will not be awarded.

New competitors please ask any HSCCQ member for information or assistance.

Day Membership of HSCCQ and CAMS Level 1 licences will be available for the event from the event secretary.

The event will not be catered but drinks will be available.

PASSENGERS AS INSTRUCTORS ONLY

This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the CAMS MSPRA Policy. Passengers are only allowed where their role is as an 'Instructor'.

- (a) A Briefing must be attended by each Driver and Passenger (and guardians of each Passenger if Passenger is under 18 years of age) conducted by the Clerk of the Course prior to the MSPRA commencing.
- (b) Instructors must:
 - i. Be experienced and have the permission of the Clerk of Course. The suitability of the Passenger is at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.
 - ii. Wear the same protective gear as a Driver in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
 - iii. Be fitted and restrained as required for each Automobile with consideration for their physical attributes.
 - iv. Complete a Passenger Ride Entry Form and disclaimer.
 - v. Drivers must fill out a Passenger Ride Entry Form to ride as a Passenger.
- (c) Vehicles and Apparel used must pass Scrutiny.
- (d) Vehicles shall only carry one Passenger at a time, unless otherwise approved by CAMS.
