



Supplementary Regulations Holden Sporting Car Club Qld Khanacross Sunday 12/11/2017

The Event

The event shall be a Multi-Club Khanacross (Sealed Surface) and be known as the HSCCQ Interclub Khanacross with a Come & Try component.

Authority

The event is authorised by CAMS permit No. 417/1211/03 and shall be conducted under the provisions of the International Sporting Code of FIA and the NCRs of CAMS, the current CAMS Khanacross Regulations, the CAMS Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity, these supplementary regulations and any further regulations, addenda and instructions as may be issued, subject to NCR 69 of the current CAMS Manual. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au.

Entries

Entries open upon publication of these regulations and close at the venue 9.30 am 12/11/2017

The entry fee shall be \$45.00 Adults and \$30.00 Juniors and must be submitted with the Event Secretary prior to the event accompanied by an official entry form. The maximum number of entries will be 70, accepted in order of receipt. Entries may be refused in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual.

Come & Try CAMS Day licence will be \$25.00, available at the event.

CTP Insurance

All competitors of Queensland registered vehicles should present to the secretary of the event a current CTP Insurance extension for the entered vehicle for that day.

Licences

All competitors must be a member of a CAMS affiliated club and be in possession of a relevant and current CAMS licence L2NS, L2NSJ or superior. Such licence must be presented to the secretary of the event. All partnerships and registered companies must hold a CAMS Competitors Licence.

CAMS Level One (Day) licences and Day Membership of HSCCQ will be available for Come & Try people.

Abandonment

The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event if the total number of competitors is less than twenty (25). The event may be altered, postponed, abandoned or cancelled at the sole discretion of the organisers, subject to the provisions of NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.

Venue

The event shall be conducted at, Willowbank Raceway 12th November 2017. The type of surface shall be sealed.

Timetable

Scrutiny will start at the venue at 8.30 am. 12/11/2017. A briefing of competitors will be held at 9.45 am. The event shall start at 10.00 am.

Alcohol, drug and other Substances

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence

of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

Scrutiny

Vehicles shall comply with General Requirements for Cars & Drivers Schedule A and Group 4H of the current CAMS Manual. Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual. Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions. All vehicles with a CAMS Log Book must be present it at Scrutiny.

Approved **crash helmets are required** for all vehicles and **suitable eye protection** (not sunglasses) is required for **open vehicles**. Choice of tyres will be restricted to **road tyres** “ slick, rally, winter tread, studded or cut tyres will not be accepted (except for class F vehicles) and any car running these may be excluded”.

A **Fire Extinguisher of 900g** which complies with Schedule H of the NCR **must** be fitted.

Apparel

Apparel, including helmets, shall comply with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual.

Neck to wrist to ankle clothing is required and must be worn in all vehicles. All competitors must present the following documents at Scrutiny: A current CAMS competition licence, current CAMS affiliation card.

Classes

Class A: Up to 1400cc	Production Vehicles	Forced Induction Engine Vehicles (Turbo & Supercharged) will have their capacity multiplied by 1.7 Petrol, 1.5 Diesel.
Class B: 1401cc to 1600cc	Production Vehicles	
Class C: 1601cc to 2000cc	Production Vehicles	
Class D: 2000cc to 3000cc	Production Vehicles	
Class E: 3000cc and over	Production Vehicles	Rotary Engine Vehicles will be multiplied by 1.8
Class F: Specials		
Class G: Production 4(all) Wheel Drive Vehicles		
Class H: Modified Production Vehicles 2 wheel drive		
Class I: Modified Production Vehicles 4 wheel drive		

Rotary engine vehicles engine capacity will be determined by multiplying the capacity by 1.8 times.

Supercharged & Turbocharged engine vehicles will have their engine capacity multiplied by 1.7 times for spark ignition engines and 1.5 times for diesel engines.

Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual. Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions.

Convoy Run

A convoy run shall be conducted of all competitors on each course before competition starts on each new course as per 8.1 of the Khanacross regs.

Timing

Electronic & or Manual timing shall be used. Timing shall start at the competitors own time, when the vehicle breaks the designated timing line and cease when the foremost part of the vehicle crosses the designated finish line.

Penalties

Penalties shall be awarded in accordance with the CAMS Khanacross Regulations.

A penalty of +5 seconds will apply for boundaries not each pole otherwise as per above.

Pointscoreing (Results)

All competitors shall be ranked according to their total scores after all tests have been completed by all competitors.

Come & Try people will not be included in results.

Protests/ Appeals

Protests or appeals must be made in accordance with Part XII (Protests) and Part XIII (Appeals) of the current NCR's.

Judges of Fact

All officials and timekeepers at test areas shall be deemed as Judges of Fact in accordance with NCR 181 of the current CAMS Manual and Article 16 of the Khanacross Regulations.

General

Trophies will not be awarded.

Start and Finish order shall be in accordance with Article 10 of the Khanacross Regulations.

No passenger may be carried in any vehicle without special permission of the clerk of course (8.2 Khanacross regs) but may be carried on a convoy run.
