The Event

The event shall be a **Multi-Club Motorkhana** and be known as the HSCCQ Interclub Motorkhana

Authority

The event is authorised by Motorsport Australia permit No. **421/1605/02** and shall be conducted under the provisions of the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices and the National Competition Rules (NCR) of Motorsport Australia, the current Motorsport Australia Khanacross Regulations, the Motorsport Australia Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Come and Try Policy, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations, addenda and instructions. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Motorsport Australia Safety 1st and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at www.motorsport.org.au Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia in relation to the event. Entries

Entries open upon publication of these regulations and close at the venue 9.30 am 16/05/2021
The entry fee shall be \$60 Adults and \$30 for Juniors and must be accompanied by an official entry form. The maximum number of entries will be 70 in order of receipt. Entries may be refused in accordance with the NCR's of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

REMEMBER Social Distancing must be adhered to at Book-In and Scrutiny.

CTP Insurance

All competitors of Queensland registered vehicles must present to the secretary of the event a current CTP Insurance extension for the entered vehicle for that day.

Licences

Day Membership of HSCCQ and Motorsport Australia Level 1 Come & Try licences will be available for the event
All competitors must be a member of a Motorsport Australia affiliated club and be in possession of a relevant and current Motorsport Australia Speed/Junior licence or higher. Such licence must be presented to the secretary of the event. All partnerships and registered companies must hold a Motorsport Australia Competitors Licence.

Abandonment

The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event if the total number of competitors is less than twenty (20). The event may be altered, postponed, abandoned or cancelled at the sole discretion of the organisers, subject to the provisions of NCR 11.

Venue

The event shall be conducted at, Willowbank Raceway 16th May 2021 The type of surface shall be sealed.

Timetable

Pre event Scrutiny to be completed by competitors when entering, spot checks may be conducted on the day.
A briefing of competitors may be held at 10.15 am.
The event shall start at 10.30 am.

Alcohol, drug and other Substances

The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of any drug or other banned substance and subject to a penalty for a breach of the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.
Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.
The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a

Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at www.motorsport.org.au

Scrutiny

Self Scrutiny will be used but we may check a car if required

Vehicles shall comply with General Requirements for Cars & Drivers Schedule A and Group 4H of the current Motorsport Australia Manual. Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current Motorsport Australia Manual. Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions. All vehicles with a Motorsport Australia Log Book must present it at Book-In and or Scrutiny. Approved crash helmets are required for all open vehicles. All competitors must present the following documents at book-in, Motorsport Australia Licence, Club Membership & **CTP Extension as applicable.**
(All registered cars need a CTP Extension, check your car registration papers and ask that insurer for a Rally Extension for the day of the event, giving them the name of the event and location.)

Motorkhana Classes

There will be seven classes as follows:

Class A= wheelbase up to 2150mm

Class B= wheelbase from 2151 to 2390mm

Class C= wheelbase from 2391 to 2574mm

Class D= wheelbase 2575mm and over

Class E = Production vehicles with 4 wheel drive

Class F = Front wheel drive specials

Class G = Rear wheel drive specials

Production vehicles fitted with a hand braking system other than:

• Standard • Changed mechanical advantage • Hydraulic • Altered ratchet

Or any vehicle which in the opinion of Motorsport Australia represents an attempt to circumvent or defeat the spirit of the concept of a production vehicle shall be classified as a special. Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current Motorsport Australia Manual. Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions.

Timing

Electronic & or Manual timing shall be used. Timing shall start at the competitors own time, when the vehicle breaks the designated timing line and cease when the foremost part of the vehicle crosses the finish line.

Penalties

Penalties shall be awarded in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Khanacross and Motorkhana Regulations.

Judges of Fact

All officials and timekeepers at test areas shall be deemed as Judges of Fact in accordance with the NCR's and 18.2 / 18.3 of the National Motorkhana Code.

Protests/ Appeals

Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR's of the current Motorsport Australia Manual

General

Day Membership of HSCCQ and Motorsport Australia Level 1 licences will be available for the event from the event secretary.

The event will not be catered but drinks will be available.

PASSENGERS AS INSTRUCTORS ONLY

This Event may include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the Motorsport Australia MSPRA Policy. Passengers are only allowed where their role is as an 'Instructor'.
