The Event

The event shall be a **State Championship Motorkhana** and be known as the **QLD Motorkhana Championship & Series**

Authority

The Event is authorised by Motorsport Australia permit No **424/2605/01** and shall be conducted under the provisions of the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices and the National Competition Rules (NCR) of Motorsport Australia, the Motorkhana Standing Regulations, the Motorsport Australia Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Come and Try Policy, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations, addenda and instructions. The Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Safety 1st, Integrity and Legal, and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at www.motorsport.org.au. Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia in relation to the event. Entries

Entries open upon publication of these regulations and close Friday 24th May, 2024

The Entry fee is \$70.00 Adults and \$35.00 for Juniors and must be accompanied by an official entry form

- Entries must be submitted in advance via online entry form at motorsport.org.au
- Owners of any (Qld) road registered vehicles must obtain their CTP Rally Extension letter and email it to entries@hscq.com prior to the day of the event. This is obtained by requesting it from the CTP provider listed on the vehicle registration.
- Entries may be refused in accordance with the NCR.
- The maximum number of entries will be 60 in order of receipt

Licences

Competitors will have their Motorsport Australia licences checked prior to the event through the Motorsport Australia electronic platform and it is **not** required to show their licence in person at the Secretary's Office.

All competitors must be a member of a Motorsport Australia affiliated club and be in possession of a relevant and current Motorsport Australia Competition Licence Speed/Speed Junior or higher.

Abandonment

The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event if the total number of competitors is less than twenty (20). The Event Organisers reserves the right to abandon, postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR.

Venue

The event shall be conducted at, Queensland Raceway 26th May 2024. The type of surface shall be sealed.

Timetable

Gates open 7.00am 26/05/2024

Scrutiny will start at the venue at 8.00 am

Competitors Briefing will be held at 9.45 am.

Competition shall start at 10.00 am.

Integrity, Alcohol, Drugs and Other Substances

Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Motorsport Australia's Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at www.motorsport.org.au.

Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.

Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.

Smoking

Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and "vaping") and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defueling operation.

Scrutiny

Scrutiny will be conducted at this event.

Vehicles shall comply with General Requirements for Cars & Drivers Schedule A and Group 4H of the Motorsport Australia Manual. Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the Motorsport Australia Manual. Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions. All vehicles with a Motorsport Australia Log Book must present at Scrutiny.

Approved crash helmets are required for all open vehicles in Motorkhana.

Motorkhana Classes

Class A 2WD, wheelbase up to 2150mm Production Automobiles

Class B 2WD, wheelbase 2151 - 2390mm Production Automobiles

Class C 2WD, wheelbase 2391 - 2574mm Production Automobiles

Class D 2WD, wheelbase 2575mm and over Production Automobiles

Class E 4WD (which must be driven in the four-wheel drive mode throughout the competition) Production Automobiles

Class F Specials – Front wheel drive Non-Production Vehicles

Class G Specials – Rear wheel drive Non-Production Vehicles

Timing

Electronic & or Manual timing shall be used. Timing shall start at the competitors own time when the vehicle breaks the designated timing line and cease when the foremost part of the vehicle crosses the finish line.

Event Structure

A minimum of six (6) and a maximum of twelve (12) tests will be conducted, chosen by the Organisers from the following list tests from the Motorsport Australia Motorkhana Tests Booklet

Only one attempt will be permitted at each test, with the exception of a rerun having been granted by the Clerk of the Course.

Penalties

Penalties shall be awarded in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Motorkhana Standing Regulations.

Awards:

1st in class
1st, 2nd and 3rd outright

QMS Point Scoring (Results)

All competitors in the Queensland Motorkhana Series shall be ranked according to their total handicap times after all tests have been completed by all competitors. Competitors shall be awarded points according to their ranking which shall count towards their overall total for the Queensland Motorkhana Series. The points shall be awarded in accordance with the method decided on by the Queensland Motorkhana Appendix.

QMC Points/Awards

Qld Championship Competitors shall be ranked by outright time overall and in Class.
One (1) run for each test

Inter Club Challenge (ICC) Point Scoring (Results)

ICC Competitors shall be scored for Tests 1 through to 10.
One (1) run for each test

Judges of Fact

All officials and timekeepers at test areas shall be deemed as Judges of Fact in accordance with NCR in the Motorsport Australia Manual and Motorkhana Standing Regulations.

Protests/ Appeals

Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.

General
